Platinum Bushvelder newspaper | Thabazimbi – A significant political shift unfolded this week as the Thabazimbi Local Municipality (TLM) elected a new mayor and speaker during a special council meeting held on Tuesday, 17 March 2026.

The meeting, convened in the council chamber and facilitated by municipal manager Gopolang Clement Letsoalo, followed motions of no confidence in the previous leadership.

In a unanimous decision, councillor Andries Tshukudu was elected as the new mayor, while councillor Daniel Mampeule was appointed as speaker. The appointments mark a pivotal moment for the municipality, with council expressing confidence in the new leadership's ability to strengthen service delivery and deepen community engagement.

Addressing council, speaker Mampeule emphasised the importance of unity and collaboration in tackling the challenges facing the municipality, while reinforcing a commitment to transparency and accountability.

Council also approved the adjustments budget for the 2025/26 financial year, with additional matters referred to the executive committee. A follow-up special council meeting is expected before the end of the week to address outstanding issues.

The municipality extended its gratitude to the outgoing leadership, while urging residents, stakeholders and staff to support the newly elected team as TLM enters a new chapter focused on progress and improved quality of life.

Rising Waters, Rising Risk: Crocodile River Warning Issued

Platinum Bushvelder newspaper | Thabazimbi – Residents in the Thabazimbi area are urged to exercise extreme caution following a safety warning issued by WildMed Emergency Services on 16 March 2026. Recent heavy rains have caused the Crocodile River to rise significantly, with strong and dangerous currents now flowing through the area. Of particular concern is the Elandskuil low water bridge, where water levels have already reached the underside of the bridge.

WildMed Emergency Services is closely monitoring the situation and will continue to keep the public informed. In the meantime, they strongly warn residents not to attempt crossing flooded bridges, swimming in the river, or using inflatables such as inner tubes or small boats.

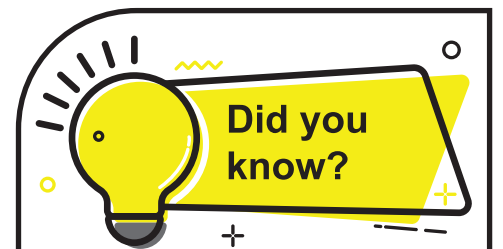

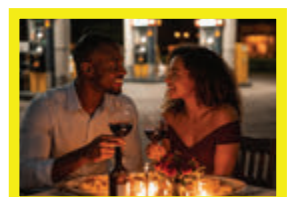

Groen en goud gees leef voort by HFM

Rugby-legende Bakkies Botha saam met Hoërskool Frikkie Meyer se 1ste rugbyspan tydens die oorhandiging van hul nuwe ondersteunershemde.

Botha, bekend as die “gentle giant” en 'n sleutelspeler in Suid-Afrika se 2007 Rugby Wêreldbeker-wenspan, het internasionaal naam gemaak vir sy fisieke spel en onwrikbare spanlojaliteit. Sy teenwoordigheid alleen was reeds 'n hoogtepunt – maar dit was sy boodskap wat werklik harte geraak het.

Saam met spanlede Casey Rothman en Timon van der Walt het hulle vroeg opgedaag, met duidelike entoesiasme en opregte betrokkenheid.
